

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
FRIDAY, MARCH 6, 2020**

At 10:00 a.m. Chairperson Jack Seward Jr. called to order in special session a meeting of the Washington County Board of Supervisors. The meeting took place in the Washington County Board of Supervisors chambers which are located in the Washington County Courthouse. Items on the agenda included the following: approval of agenda; closed session pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(j) to discuss the purchase of particular real estate only where premature disclosure could be reasonably expected to increase the price the governmental body would have to pay for that property; discussion and action regarding the possible acquisition of property; public comment, adjourn. Supervisors Stan Stoops, Abe Miller and Bob Yoder were also present. Supervisor Richard Young was absent.

Others attending were: Sue Meeks, Deputy County Auditor, Jacob Thorius, County Engineer, Tony Janney, Assistant County Attorney.

All motions were passed unanimously by those Supervisors in attendance unless noted otherwise.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Yoder, the Board voted to approve the agenda as published.

At 10:02 a.m. on motion by Seward, seconded by Stoops, the Board voted by roll call vote to go into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(j) to discuss the purchase of particular real estate only where premature disclosure could be reasonably expected to increase the price the governmental body would have to pay for that property.

At 10:09 a.m. on motion by Stoops, seconded by Miller, the Board voted to end the closed session and return to open session.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Stoops, the Board voted to allow County Engineer Jacob Thorius and Assistant County Attorney Tony Janney to discuss the possible purchase of particular real estate with the land owner.

There was no public comment.
