

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING  
TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2019**

Chairperson Bob Yoder called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. in the Courthouse chambers in regular session. Items on the agenda included the following: approval of agenda; personnel change request – Sheriff; discussion and possible action regarding establishment of a chain of command with Edge Consulting; discussion and action regarding proposed contract for providing inmate meals; public comment; adjourn. Supervisors Stan Stoops, Jack Seward, Jr., and Richard Young, were also present. Supervisor Abe Miller was absent.

All motions were passed unanimously unless noted otherwise.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Seward, the Board voted to approve the agenda as published.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Young, the Board voted to acknowledge a personnel change request from the Sheriff for the hiring of Jayse Horning as a full-time employee at the rate of \$23.85 per hour and with an effective date of April 4, 2019.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Young, the Board voted to establish a point of contact chain of command for working with Edge Consulting Engineers, Inc. for civil engineering of the P25 LMR System Communication Site Construction Washington County Radio Project contract dated March 19, 2019 and to designate Communications Supervisor Cara Sorrells and Sheriff Jared Schneider for project management decisions and to designate Supervisors Richard Young and Jack Seward, Jr. for project milestone sign-offs and for work order/change order communication on behalf of Washington County.

On motion by Yoder, seconded by Young, the Board voted to table action regarding a proposed contract for providing inmate meals.

There was no public comment.

At 9:14 a.m. on motion by Stoops, seconded by Young, the Board voted to adjourn.
