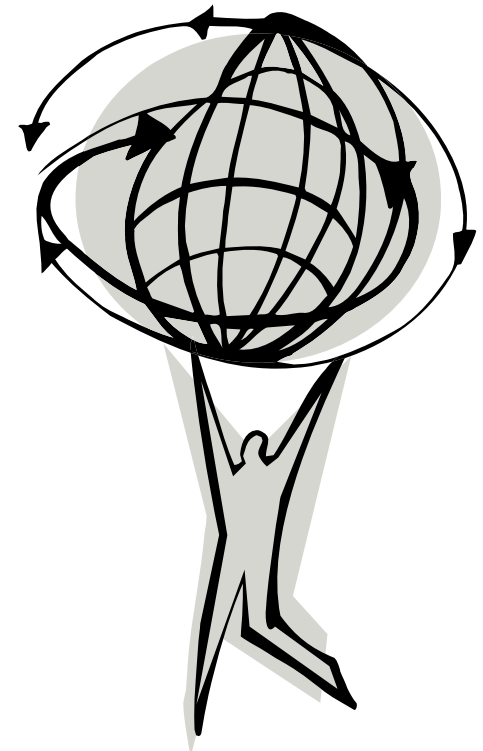

Mission Statement: Washington County aims to provide all eligible individuals with the services they need and to do so with a management plan that respects their needs and preserves their dignity, while enhancing individual choice. It is the goal of Washington County to facilitate a centralized, efficient service system that involves input from county taxpayers, individuals of service and their advocates.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING?

1. Persons with Mental Retardation (MR)

2. Persons with a Mental Health Crisis (MH)

3. Persons with Mental Illness (MI)

4. Persons with Chronic Mental Illness (CMI)

5. Person with Developmental Disabilities (DD):

Washington County does not have funds available for individuals with the sole diagnosis of DD except for 1) Individuals who have been grandfathered into eligibility for services or 2) Individuals who are enrolled in entitlement programs (Medicaid/Title XIX) that the County is mandated to fund.

6. Persons with Brain Injury (BI):

Washington County does not have funds available for individuals with the sole diagnosis of BI except for 1) Individuals who reside or are coming out of an ICF/MR or 2) Individuals who are enrolled in entitlement programs (Medicaid/Title XIX) that the County is mandated to fund.

HOW DO I KNOW IF I AM ELIGIBLE?

1. Have a Diagnosed Disability Covered by the Plan:

- a. Mental Illness
- b. Chronic Mental Illness
- c. Mental Retardation

* Preventative mental health services can be accessed through the Washington County Mental Health Center regardless of the presence of a diagnosis and other mandated services may be received without one of these diagnoses.

2. Meet Income and Resource Financial Eligibility Guidelines.

3. The Requested Service or Support is Covered by the County Management Plan.

4. There are No Other Funding Sources Available to Pay for the Requested Service(s).

HOW DO I KNOW IF I AM APPROVED OR DENIED?

After receipt of a CPC application, WCMHDS staff will review the application information and make a decision whether or not the applicant is eligible for county funding or if there is a need for additional information. A Notice of Decision will be sent within fifteen (15) working days to inform the individual of the status of their application.

* Every individual who applies has the right to appeal any decision of funding. The process to appeal is listed on the Notice of Decision.

WHAT ARE THE APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES?

Individuals must attend all scheduled appointments and comply with their treatment plan to ensure continued county funding. Additionally, some services may have a co-payment based on the individual's net income and service type.

LOCAL ACCESS POINTS

Local Access Points are local agencies that will assist individuals to apply for Washington County funded services and will inform applicants of all the county contracted agencies through which services may be received.
