***Full Text of Public Measure A (City of Washington):				
<p>“Shall the City of Washington, Iowa impose a hotel/motel tax as provided by Chapter 423A, <u>Code of Iowa</u>, at the rate of seven percent (7%) effective July 1, 2010, upon the gross receipts from the renting of any and all rooms in any hotel, motel, inn or public lodging house and direct that one hundred percent (100%) of revenue from this tax shall be spent for the acquisition of sites for, or constructing, improving, enlarging, equipping, repairing, operating or maintaining recreational, convention, cultural or entertainment facilities, or the payment of principal and interest on bonds or other evidence of indebtedness issued by the City for such purposes, or for the promotion and encouragement of tourist and convention business in the City and surrounding areas.”</p>
