

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2019**

Chairperson Bob Yoder called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in the Courthouse chambers in regular session. Items on the agenda included the following: approval of agenda; appointment of non-voting member to Washington County Riverboat Foundation Board; application for Class C Liquor License (LC) (Commercial) from Washington Golf and Country Club; personnel change requests – Sheriff; Quarterly Report – Sheriff; public comment; adjourn. Supervisors Abe Miller, Stan Stoops, Richard Young, and Jack Seward, Jr. were also present.

Others attending were: Sally Hart, KCII Radio; Mary Zielinski, The News; Bill Monroe, SE Iowa Union; Danielle Pettit-Majewski, County Public Health Director; Jennine Wolf, County Environmental Health Director; Bill Fiordelise and Jared Schneider, County Sheriff's Office; Patty Koller, Washington County Riverboat Foundation Executive Assistant; Amber Williams, Board of Supervisors Administrative Assistant; and citizens Charlotte Stalder, Karyl Miller, Bill Miller, and Denny Stalder.

All motions were passed unanimously unless noted otherwise.

On motion by Miller, seconded by Young, the Board voted to approve the agenda as published.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Miller, the Board voted to submit the names of Richard Young and Bob Yoder for consideration by the Washington County Riverboat Foundation Board for a 3 year term as a non-voting ex officio member of the Board. The appointment of either Yoder or Young is a result of new legislation passed by the 88th Iowa General Assembly and signed by Governor Reynolds on May 13, 2019. The legislation pertains to sports wagering and according to Senate File 617, Subsection 9, the board of directors of a qualified sponsoring organization licensed to operate gambling games shall include a member of the county board of supervisors.

On motion by Young, seconded by Stoops, the Board voted to approve, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, an application for a Class C Liquor License (LC) (Commercial) from Washington Golf and Country Club for the period of August 28, 2019 to August 27, 2020.

On motion by Miller, seconded by Stoops, the Board voted to acknowledge, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, a personnel change request from the Sheriff for the hiring of Justin Adams as a non-exempt Deputy at the biweekly rate of \$1,804.80 to begin August 15, 2019.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Seward, the Board voted to acknowledge, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, a personnel change request from the Sheriff for Jailer Mike Yoder whose rate of pay will change from \$20.36 per hour to \$23.70 per hour effective August 1, 2019.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Stoops, the Board voted to acknowledge, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, a personnel change request from the Sheriff for Jailer Dennis Boecker whose rate of pay will change from \$23.70 per hour to \$22.26 per hour effective August 1, 2019.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Young, the Board voted to acknowledge receipt of the Washington County Sheriff's quarterly report for the 4th quarter of FY 2019. The report, presented by Deputy Bill Fiordelise, included a beginning balance of \$16,517.37, total receipts in the amount of \$88,619.69 which includes unallocated funds, total disbursements of \$96,220.99, and an ending balance of \$8,916.07. The complete report is available in the office of the Washington County Auditor. Fiordelise commented that during the 4th quarter approximately \$45,000.00 in fees were collected which was approximately \$16,000.00 more than the previous quarter. Fiordelise attributed the increase to a rise in room and board revenue and non-committal transport revenue. Sheriff Jared Schneider noted that future quarterly reports may show a decrease in amounts collected for room and board, as well as transport fees, due to a recent court ruling which stipulates that a judge may determine that an individual is unable to pay such fees resulting in no reimbursement to the county.

There was no public comment.

At 9:21 a.m. on motion by Seward, seconded by Stoops, the Board voted to adjourn.
